About Mount Maunganui and Area

The region's largest shopping centre, Bayfair Plaza is right across the road from the Academy. There is also a medical centre and an aquatic leisure centre complete with waterslides, a swimming pool and gym just a couple of minutes' walk away. The public bus stops right outside the Academy, and the beach is 8 minutes' walk from the Academy's front door.





Mount Maunganui is the key attraction of Tauranga. It has a vibrant holiday feel with many cafes, bars and restaurants. The beach and amenities are among the best in the world; white sand leading down to a surf beach dotted with offshore islands. On the other side of town, there is a sheltered swimming beach which boasts of the port and recreational boating. Water-based activities include paddle-

boarding, surfing and kayaking to kite surfing, wind foiling and sailing, or of course just relaxing on the beach. For the energetic, climbing Mt Maunganui is a must experience to view the amazing sights from the top, or take a stroll through the large number of shops with something to please everyone.

Tauranga is one of the sunniest spots in New Zealand with almost 2,400 sunshine hours a year. It has become a multi-cultural city with cultural events, art galleries and festivals, libraries, theatres and performing art centres. The racecourse, parks, reserves, and magnificent harbour - all contribute to the peaceful and relaxed atmosphere enjoyed by those staying in this beautiful city. It has excellent education facilities - schools, technology institutes, and a university offering pathways to opportunities and careers for the growing student population.



We are a short trip to the native forests, an hour from Rotorua; which is the centre for cultural and geothermal activities, mud-pools and geysers, and 80 minutes from Hamilton; home to museums, galleries, a world-class zoo and botanical gardens. Cosmopolitan Auckland is only a 3-hour drive away.

Accommodation

You will either be staying at a lodge, holiday park or homestay. Where you stay depends both on the preference of the tour leader, level of supervision required and the availability of the facility.

Holiday parks offer cabins that sleep up to 6 people. They are self-catering and have shared cooking, dining room and bathroom facilities, and are generally occupied by families They typically have a barbecue, swimming pool, laundry and a games room and outdoor sports facilities.





Lodges offer 6 to 10 bed dormitory style accommodation and shared facilities, as well as smaller rooms for independent travellers. They typically have a barbecue, swimming pool, laundry and a games room and cater for individuals.

Homestay is an arrangement where you live with a New Zealand family in their home. You will have your own bedroom, mostly shared bathroom facilities, and you are provided with breakfast and evening meals. Monday to Friday. Other meals during the week may have been arranged by your tour leader, but at the weekend breakfast, lunch and dinner are provided. Homestay families include you in their weekend activities.





As in a normal family it is customary to offer help with the dishes, setting the table, or little chores around the house. It is considered polite to ask before using facilities such as using the cooker, TV etc, and to let homestay parents know if you are planning to be out late.

Your tour leader will ask you to provide as much information about yourself as possible so we can supply you with the best homestay experience.




There is an annual Jazz Festival in April, and Arts Festival in October. Multicultural Tauranga http://www.trmc.co.nz/ can help with ethnic events.
